Keywords: 3-5 keywords, sorted alphabetically {Times New Roman 11 pt.}

1. Introduction

Introduction must be written in Times New Roman 12 pt. format. Introduction is to explain the nature of the problem and its justification. Literature citation may or may not be included in this part. If citation is included, the APA 7th format should be used

2. Methodology

Methodology must be written in Times New Roman 12 pt. format. Describes materials and methods used in the study. Cite reference if the method has been previously established.

Results and discussion must be written in Times New Roman 12 pt. format. Describes experimental data, statistical analyses, interpret and explain the findings.

Conclusion must be written in Times New Roman 12 pt. format. Summarizing the importance of the findings and reminding the reader why the work presented in this paper is relevant. Opportunities for future research may be included.

Figure 1. The layout of figure should be set to in line with text (i.e., no floating figures). The figure must be in one complete piece. Annotation like addition of labels etc. should not be made within MS Word. Figures should have sufficient resolution to give acceptable appearance at 100% zoom. All figures must be referred to from the text. Previously published figures must include a reference and a copyright statement.

Table 1. Tables should be placed close to the location it is being referred to for the first time. The table size should fit either one column format.^{a,b,c,d}

Reference must be written in Times New Roman 12 pt. format. And it should be arranged alphabetically based on the last name of the first author.

Guideline

1. Font Times New Roman
2. Full article must not exceed 10 pages
3. Paper size A4, Margin 1 in or 2.54 cm
4. Set single line spacing for all components of the manuscript
5. Paragraph size (First line) 1.27 cm
6. Reference cited in the text must appear in the reference list, and each entry in the reference list must be cited in the text (use the following formats APA 7th)
7. References use the following formats APA 7th
